



Mockett's Wood update 18-06-25:



Lots of activity in the last 3 weeks, particularly in terms of new & renovated dead & live hedging around the meadow & glade areas.

We also received a big load of green poplar & cherry for hedge building from our tree surgeon Joe.

This was very useful for a mid-June volunteer session we hosted with 6 amazing staff members from SAGA. They made a great start on some large sections of dead hedging

The paths being blocked off are being re-wilded with native Woodland heavy shade tolerant seed. Recent rain should help with germination & returning paths to a natural state.

New species spotted included bracket fungus & harlequin ladybird larvae.
