

Fencing off Mocketts Wood northern strip.

The thin strip of woodland on the northern side of Mockett's Wood, adjoining the farmed field, has had a large camp built in it for over a year. This has recently been the source of complaints from local residents on the southern side of this strip. This is due to young people using the camp late at night and creating a lot of noise, plus lighting fires.

As a result, the plan for this section of the woods has been recently altered. The rest area originally planned for the current camp location, has been moved out of the northern strip and closer to the main path. This should reduce the amount of noise disturbance to residents living close to the woods.

The plan is now to completely fence off the northern strip and create a reserve to allow the woods to re-wild, plus provide an undisturbed habitat for wildlife.

Approval required:

- a) To fence off the woods northern strip**
- b) Relocate the 3rd planned seating area closer to the main path**
