During May and June, the focus has been on decorating some of the new fencing with natural wood. We've been kept supplied with materials, including some lovely Eucalyptus.

We have also had a local school making some wonderful seating and sculptures for the woods, including Lennon the Dachshund!





As per usual, we have been species spotting and found some interesting new plants and animals for our species database. A copy of our species list is currently being displayed on the noticeboard. As shown by the graph below, the overall trend for the number of species found in the woods is upward. Mockett's Wood biodiversity appears to be increasing over time.

A great deal of planning, costing and preparation has also been going on in the background. We are getting ready for the next phase of fencing in the northern section of the woodland, plus the start of building new rest areas and path boardwalk in late summer to early autumn.
